

Club Regulations

To be adhered to by any members of Vincent's Club, along with their guests

1. Unless otherwise decided by the Committee, the Club the Club's premises shall be open:
 - (a) for ten weeks of each Term from 11.00am and until 3.00pm and from 7.00pm-11.00pm on Monday to Saturday each week: and
 - (b) at such other time or times (including the first and last week of each vacation) as the Committee shall in its absolute discretion determine.
2. In accordance with Section 62 of the Licensing Act 1964, the permitted hours for the supply and/or sale of intoxicating liquor in the Club are as follows:
 - (a) on weekdays (not being Christmas Day or Good Friday) from 11.00 am to 11 pm; and
 - (b) on Sundays and Good Friday (when open for Members) from 12 pm to 3 pm and from 7 pm to 10.30 pm.
3. No intoxicating liquor shall be sold to anyone who is not a Member, a bona fide guest of a Member or to a person or persons duly authorised by the Committee.
4. Members and their guests are required to be respectably dressed in the Club at all times and a collar and tie must be worn by male Members and their male guests in the Club after 6 pm.
5. No Member shall be entitled to introduce more than three bona fide guests into the Club at any one time unless by prior arrangement with the Committee or the General Manager. All Members must sign in their guests in the Visitors Book provided for that purpose.
6. No Member shall bring a dog, other than a Guide Dog into the Club.
7. The conduct of the General Manager or any member of staff working at the Club shall in no instance be a matter of personal reprimand by any Member but all complaints must be made in a letter to the Committee, signed by the Member complaining.
8. No Member shall take away from the Club any newspaper, stationery or periodicals.
9. The use of mobile telephones in the Club's premises should be kept to a minimum, with phone and video calls restricted to the stairwell (i.e. not in the bar, lounge or dining areas). Text, e-mail and other forms of typed communication are permitted but should not be allowed to significantly affect interaction with the members and their guests.
10. No Member may reserve a table in the Club's Dining Room and Members and their male guests must wear jackets and ties at all functions held in the Dining Room
11. No food or drink shall, except by prior arrangement with the General Manager, be sent out of, or brought into the Club
